Camper Fees

The fee is \$110 per camper. There is a \$10 registration fee required. This fee is to be mailed with the application and is non-refundable. There will be a \$25 late fee applied to all campers who fail to register one week prior to desired camp week. Reservations can be confirmed by mail or by phone.



- Family Plan: For every second and third child there will be a \$10 discount per child.
- Teen Camp is for those entering the 7th grade to 18 years of age.
- Junior Camp is for those 8 to 12 years of age.
